

PTO FEBRUARY MINUTES

- Received a request for donation from the After Prom Committee - \$250 donation given to chairperson
- Discussed Author that is scheduled to be at the Primary School. Mrs. Simpson is working on a contract and will get us more information when it becomes available. The author is Tom Lithchenheld
- Discussed ink cartridges – Katie Myers offered to look into the recycling. The company that Diana found does not recycle toner cartridges, which is the majority of what we have.
- Carnival donation lists were distributed – many donations have already been received. Please email Diana Uselton any donations you receive so the master list can be kept up to date.
- Popcorn (already popped) will be donated by Weaver’s Popcorn to be sold in the kitchen.
- Early Ticket Sales – Mrs. Hallmark suggested a change in how early ticket sales are sold (usually during lunch time). The suggestion is to have the ticket requests and money sent to the office each morning which Mrs. Fugate will separate for the PTO (They must be in an envelope with the child’s name, teacher, and state carnival tickets). A PTO member will fill the orders sometime after 9:30 AM each day. Katie will donate CAT Ziploc bags to use to return the tickets to the students. The price will be the same as in past years, 5 for \$1 during the early sales and 4 for \$1 during carnival hours. Early ticket sales will take place 3/15 – 3/18. Third through fifth grade need to be done and in the teacher mailboxes by the lunch hour due to ISAT week, kindergarten through second grade can be delivered to classrooms if the lunch deadline is not met.
- Ms. Stone is talking with the building leadership team to distribute the Campbell soup label points. The members will come back to the March meeting with a “wish list” that will be prioritized by the administration.
- Tonya U. has sent requests to the teachers for carnival volunteers. She has also started to contact some of the high school clubs for help.
- Games were discussed – the inflatables are reserved (bungee run, joust, 5 in 1 bounce house, and ninja challenge) – the balloon artist is also reserved – games will be eliminated if there are not enough adult volunteers to supervise
- The theme for the Carnival is **Let the Games Begin . . . in 2010** (Olympic theme). This theme was created by Mrs. Reining’s class. Each student will receive one free ticket to the school carnival. Thanks to all the classes that participated.
